WHEN LEAVING & AT YOUR EVACUATION DESTINATION



Getting Out

- ☐ Confirm evacuation order and destination.
- ☐ Notify emergency contact that you are evacuating and location you plan to go.
- ☐ Secure medications (refrigerated), etc.

Attach ID tags to:

- ☐
 - Person
 - Mobility equipment
 - Medical devices

- ☐ Bring emergency go-bag(s) that are stocked with clothes, everyday essential items.
- ☐ Bring service animals or pet essentials.

Transportation Considerations

- ☐ Confirm accessible transportation.
- ☐ Verify lift/ramp and securement for wheelchairs.
- ☐ Ensure caregiver can accompany if required.
- ☐ Carry written instruction for transport staff.
- ☐ Ask staff to keep mobility aids with you.
- ☐ Avoid separation from essential equipment.

Shelter/Destination Accessibility

Ask for:

- ☐
 - Quiet or low-stimulation area
 - Power access for medical devices
 - Refrigeration for medications
 - Accessible toilets and showers
- ☐ Identify shelter medical staff.
- ☐ Explain needs clearly using written or prepared cards.
- ☐ Request reasonable accommodations if barriers exist.

Health & Safety Monitoring

- ☐ Maintain medication schedule.
- ☐ Monitor for stress, dehydration, infection.
- ☐ Recharge devices regularly.
- ☐ Keep emergency contacts informed.
