BEYOND THE APPOINTMENT

A Guide to a Guardian's & Conservator's Annual Reporting Requirements

New Mexico law requires that guardians and conservators file Annual Reports with the Court, to provide critical information on each Protected Person's circumstances. Other than the statutory 10-Year Review of each guardianship, the Annual Reports contain the only information regularly provided to the Court on each case, which makes them very important. A failure to file can lead to hefty fines, and incomplete or inconsistent information could trigger a Court hearing to address concerns. This presentation will go over the basics of completing the guardianship and conservatorship Annual Reports, and how to make sure all information is accurate, complete, and timely.
